Coherence

- LCAP and Community Schools framework support similar state priorities.
- LCAP, SPSA and Community School plans describe a unified and consistent set of goals and activities towards those priorities.

SHARED VISION AND GOALS

Data

- Needs/assets assessments for Community Schools provide data for the LCAP.
- Community Schools increase access to data and input from students, families and community.
- Data collection to measure Community School and LCAP progress can be combined and streamlined.

Sustainability

 Incorporating elements of Community Schools implementation into the LCAP reinforces district priority goals and actions aligned to the sustainability of Community Schools.

Meetings

- At the site, Site Council and Community School Advisory Committees can be the same group.
- At the district, meetings for different initiatives (Community School, MTSS, PBIS, SEL, etc) may be combined to reduce meeting overload.
